Welcome to version 2.0 of the scholarship list. The changes in this list (as compared to the previous one) have been mentioned below.

There are NUMEROUS scholarships available for study abroad. The Rotary, JN tata, and GD Sethna Scholarships are MUST apply scholarships. I was able to apply for just one of the above (GD Sethna) because I was late. Please don't repeat the same mistake.

### **TIME TO APPLY:**

If you plan to go for August the next year, you should start applying from JULY in the PREVIOUS Year. *For example, if you have to go for August 2005, you should start applying for the scholarships from July/ September 2004 i.e. 11 months before hand.*

*This is particularly true of the Rotary scholarship fund, which issues the application forms in July.*
